To qualify for Student Support Services, applicants must also be pursuing an eventual four-year degree or be enrolled in a transferable Ozarka program. Student Support Services provides members with free tutoring, academic advising, transfer counseling, transfer trips, financial aid counseling, financial and economic literacy, information on Federal Student Aid, assistance with FAFSA, informational workshops, and cultural opportunities.
