Fall 2009 ArkADE Student Scholarship

Amount: \$500 one time award.

Minimum Qualifications:

- > Student must have completed 12 semester credit hours of college work with at least 3 credit hours of developmental education coursework. Developmental coursework may also be described as basic skills, pre-college level, or remedial coursework. These classes will include courses in basic English, basic mathematics, college reading improvement, and remedial study skills.
- > Student must have attained a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on all coursework completed.
- > Student must be enrolled in an Arkansas college or university.
(Student must not have a college degree.)

Criteria:

The student recipient will be chosen based on the following considerations and maximum points:

- Personal Essay
 - Goals and challenges: 20 points
 - Impact of developmental education: 20 points
 - Financial Need: 20 points
- Scholarship: 20 points
- Written recommendation from a faculty member or a faculty advisor: 20 points

Application process:

1. Complete the attached application and print it.
2. Submit the following by **June 15, 2009** to:

 - a. Completed application form.

- b. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member or a faculty advisor at the student's college/university.
- c. One to two-page personal essay by the applicant outlining his/her educational and career goals and the challenges faced as a college student, including financial need not met. State the impact of developmental education courses and learning support on your progress toward your goals.
- d. A current, official college transcript showing cumulative grade point average.
- e. A statement from the Registrar's Office validating your Fall 2009 enrollment and credit hours.
