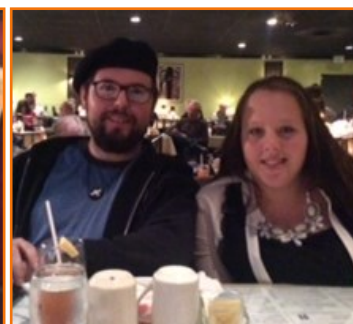
REGISTRATION FOR SPRING CLASSES
