

FSA ID: The FSA ID is the username and password you use on federal student aid websites such as fafsa.gov and studentloans.gov. Please note: the student and parent must EACH have an email address and EACH set up an FSA ID.

- Go to fsaid.ed.gov
- Create a username and password, and enter your email address.
- Enter your name, date of birth, Social Security number, contact information, and challenge questions and answers.
- Review your information, and read and accept the terms and conditions.
- Confirm your email address using the secure code which will be sent to the email address
 you entered when you created your FSA ID. Once you verify your email address, you can
 use it instead of your username to log-in to the FAFSA website.

NOTE: A new FAFSA has to be completed for <u>every academic year</u> that you attend college.
