Funding Sources for College: Other Grant and Scholarship Opportunities

1) Apply for Ozarka Foundation Scholarships

- Click on “FINANCE”
- Click on “APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS” (on the right side of the screen)
- Click on the arrow that says “BEGIN”
- Fill out the application
- Click “SUBMIT APPLICATION”
- Go to the final step in the process “COMPLETE ESSAY”
 - Write a one-page essay in MS Word (or type it into the application directly)
 - The essay should tell about you and your education and career goals. (Your application WILL NOT be considered if you fail to complete the essay portion.)
- Click “Choose File” to upload your one-page essay to the application.
- Click “SUBMIT ESSAY”
