Apply for Ozarka Foundation Scholarships

In your myOzarka account:

1. Click on “FINANCE”
2. Click on “APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS” (on the right side of the screen)
3. Click on the arrow that says “BEGIN”
4. Fill out the application.
5. Click “SUBMIT APPLICATION”
6. Go to the final step in the process “COMPLETE ESSAY”
7. Write a one-page essay in MS Word (or type it into the application directly). The essay should tell about you and your goals for your education and career. (***WITHOUT THIS ESSAY YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED***)
8. Click “Choose File” to upload your one-page essay to the application.
9. Click “SUBMIT ESSAY”
